ORDINANCE NO. 662

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING ANIMAL EXCREMENT WITHIN CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Dallas City is authorized, pursuant to Illinois law, to utilize its police power to promote and regulate the public welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the continuance of animal excrement upon the ground is a danger to the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF DALLAS CITY AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all owners or handlers of dogs, cats, or other domesticated animals who are keeping, storing, walking, exercising, or in any other manner present within the city limits of the City of Dallas City shall be responsible for the clean up of any feces or other excrement deposited by the animal on either private or public property, sidewalks, curbs, lawns, or streets.

2. That this Ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage as provided by Illinois law.
