The Dallas City City Council held its regular meeting on November 29, 2012, at 6 p.m. Mayor Higgins called the meeting to order with the following commissioners present: Esther Newberry, Tom Schaefer, and Bob Weese. Harold Northup was absent.

There were no others in attendance.

Discussed replacing the water line on East Fourth Street from Osage Street to Linn Street. Per a letter on November 9, 2012, Klingner and Associates has advised the city that their preliminary estimate for this project is \$84,000, and their engineering contract would not exceed \$10,000. These figures do not include the cost of any construction inspections. A motion was made by Weese, and 2nd by Newberry to accept the engineering contract with Klingner and Associates for the amount not to exceed \$10,000. Newberry, Northup, Schaefer, and Weese AYE.

Bob Weese reported that he has contacted some companies about the possible installation of an emergency siren in town. The companies that he has contacted are willing to come and look at the town and give an estimate of the cost.

A motion was made by Northup, and 2^{nd} by Newberry to adjourn the meeting. Newberry, Northup, Schaefer, and Weese AYE.
