A motion was made by Newberry, and 2nd by Gold to appoint Rick Bowlyou to the position of City Building Inspector for the purpose of determining the amount of damage to properties after the flood of 2008. Ellison, Gold, Newberry, and Northup AYE.

Discussed the alley behind Don Mohr's residence. The City will check out the problem.

Discussed the manhole in the sidewalk by the Oriano property.

A motion was made by Ellison, and 2^{nd} by Northup to adjourn the meeting. Ellison, Gold, Newberry, and Northup AYE.
